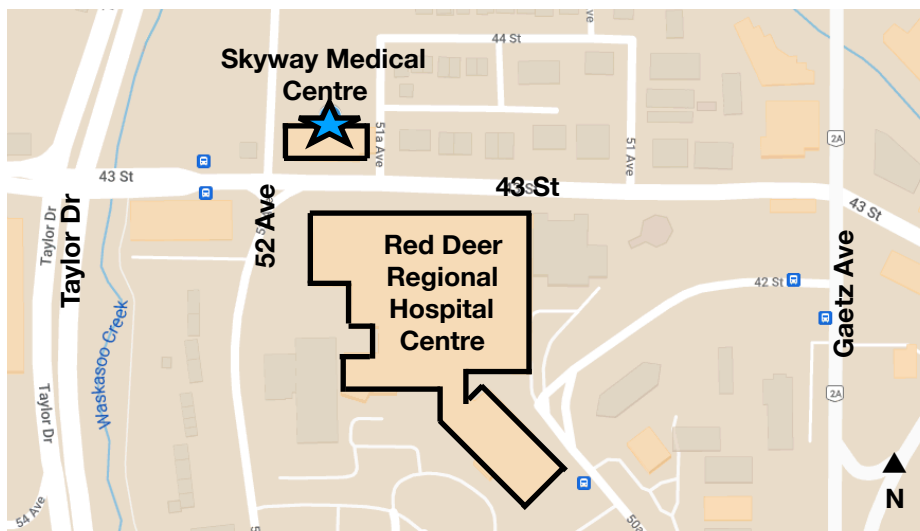

The Orthopedic Trauma Clinic is designed to provide initial consultation with an orthopedic surgeon for the management of recent bone and soft tissue injuries such as fractures, dislocations, and tendon ruptures that have a high likelihood of requiring urgent surgery.



The Central Alberta Orthopedics Trauma Clinic is located on third floor of the Skyway Medical Centre.

The Skyway Medical Centre is found directly across 43rd street, north of the Red Deer Regional Hospital Centre.

The Orthopedic Trauma Clinic is on weekdays, Monday to Friday, with the exception of statutory holidays. All patients for the clinic are expected to arrive between 7:30am - 8:00am. It is important to arrive on time to clinic. Patients arriving late to clinic may be asked to come back another day if the on-call orthopedic surgeon is no longer available.

Patients are advised to not eat or drink anything from midnight prior to their appointment. In some rare instances, patients have been able to have surgery on the same day as their consultation with the orthopedic surgeon. It is more common to have surgery within a few days of the consultation.

Patients should wear clothing that allows easy access to their injured extremity so that it may be examined during their consultation.
